Just My thoughts..... and from my home in UKI NSW

I was only using google maps and it doesn't show some roads that may take more direct routes. All times and klms based on Google.

- Day 1 – UKI to Mitchell (8 -9 hrs) Leave UKI 5am allows 9 hrs + 1hour in total breaks.
 - First meet Point (Depending on direction people take) - BP, 1420 Warrego Hwy, Blacksoil QLD 4306 – 7:30am departure.
 - Second Meeting point (Depending on direction people take) – Dalby 10am Departure.
 - Or meet at Major Mitchell Caravan Park or Artesian Spa @ Mitchell
 - Artesian Spa (Open 8-11:30, 2-6pm) 7 Days (aim to arrive around 3pm)
 - Spend night at Major Mitchell Caravan Park (\$20 night Un Powered)

- Day 2 - Mitchell to Adavale (6hrs)
 - Check at Charleville Police or information Centre on Adavale Road Conditions (Alternative Charleville to Quilpie direct)
 - Charleville Lunch

 - Free Camping and showers
 - Claimed best bush pub
- Day 3 -- Adavale – Windorah (7 hrs – 360klms)
 - Old Adavale – Quilpie Road (2 hrs)
 - Quilpie Rest stop and tours, Baldy Top Lookout, Swimming pool
 - If staying the night (due to Adavale Bypass) \$21 Unpowered.

 - Quilpie to Windorah (4.5 hrs, 250Klm)
- Day 4 – Windorah to Birdsville (6.5 hrs, 386ks)
 - Sights Possible – Beetoota Racecourse, Shallow Lake?
 - Arrive Birdsville
- Day 5 – Rest day Birdsville
 - Birdsville Caravan Park -\$15 per night un powered

- Day 6 – Rest day Birdsville (meet up with others wanting faster trip)

- Final Vehicle Checks, preparations etc. Satellite phone check etc)
 - Shopping, food stocks, Ice etc.
- Day 7 – Start Simpson Desert Crossing
 - I do not have data on the crossing.
- Day 11 – approx. time of arrival in Alice Springs.
 - 1 – 2 days at Alice Springs for Repairs, vehicle checks etc if required.

 - Mountain Bike Trails – or Bushwalk trails around Old Telegraph
- Day 13 – Meerenie Loop to Kings Canyon (5.5 hrs, 322ks)
 - Alice Springs to Kings Canyon
 - Stopping all stations (scenery and sights along the way)
 - Camping at Kings Canyon
 - Bush walk up the gorge.
- Day 14,15,16 – Kings Canyon to Yulara (4hrs, 303ks)
 - Yulara Camp Ground Camping
 - 3nights Pay 2 Unpowered = \$72 – 1to2 people
 - Uluru
 - The OLGAS – 43 Klms away
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- Day 13 – 16 - Alternative do in reverse
 - Drive from Alice to Yulara via Stuart and Lasseter Highway
 - 3 nights in Yulara
 - Uluru
 - The Olgas
 - Other
 - Drive to Kings Canyon
 - Camping and Bush walks
 - Drive to Alice Springs
- Day 17 - Yulara (or Alice) to Coober Pedy (8.5hrs, 733ks)
 - Camping or Accomodation at Coober Pedy
- Day 18 - Coober Pedy to Lyndhurst (8hrs, 453ks)
 - Camping at Lyndhurst
- Day 19, 20, 21 – Strezlecki Track to Innamincka (21hrs, 459ks)
- Day 22 – Innamincka – Thargominda (11hrs???, 369ks)
- Day 23 – Thargominda – St George (6hrs, 491ks) or 9hrs to Goondawindi
 - Fare well dinner at St George
- Day 24 – Depart for Home possibly different ways (8hrs, 603ks)
 - For me I will go via Goondawindi, warrick, Kyogle, and home.
